The Hope Cup 2025 came to a close last weekend with Riverside All-Stars levelling up the series with their second win in two years. It stands at 2-2 in terms of victories making 2026 even more exciting already. However, the cricket match is really only the vehicle for a greater purpose - raising compassion, awareness and funds to support those living on the streets and sleeping rough. That is why I'm pleased to say that with the vast majority of the finance settled we have raised in excess of \$75,000. When expenses are taken into account our grand profit total should be in the region of \$65,000.

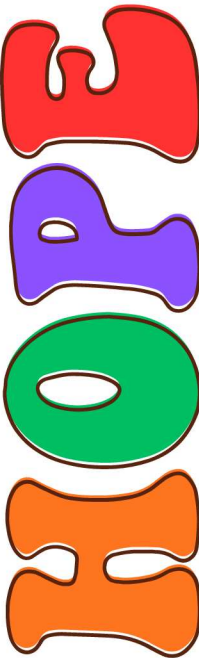
