Read John 16:12-15

Q1. How would you describe the Holy Spirit to a person who has no knowledge of Christianity?

Q2. When Jesus describes the Holy Spirit with a personal pro-noun (he, him) what does that mean to you?

Q3. Romans 8:27 NIV says “*And he who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit is because he intercedes for the saints according to the will of God.*” What is your understanding of the word mind? How would you describe your mind? Why is it important for us to know the Holy Spirit has a mind?

Not only does the Bible say the Holy Spirit has a mind but it says he has feelings and emotions. Read Ephesians 4:25-30 and you’ll find out that your actions can bring sorrow and grief to the Holy Spirit?

Q4. How do you *feel* about God the Holy Spirit, who Jesus said resides inside of you, having feelings?

Q5. The Holy Spirit also has a will and desires. His giving of spiritual gifts to us is based on his will, his decisions (read 1 Corinthians 12:11). What kind of things do you think sway his decisions as he distributes spiritual gifts?

Impersonal forces or powers do not have minds, emotions or wills. The Bible makes it abundantly clear that the Holy Spirit is a person and the disciples certainly knew Him as a person (Read Acts 10:19). Darren in his sermon said “the Holy Spirit is not a power to be harnessed but a person to be followed.”

Q6. How are you currently relating to the person of the Holy Spirit? How does your answer to this question make you want to pray?
